The school is an IB World School and one of the leading academic schools in the region. Located on the western fringe of Cairo, the School enjoys the benefits of a modern, purpose-built, spacious campus with state of the art facilities.

### **Remuneration**

The school operates a similar teaching scale to schools in the UK which increases with teaching experience. All salaries are tax free and paid in Pounds Sterling. The current basic salary for a teacher with three years' experience is £35,000 p.a. while the salary of the majority of staff (six years experience or more) is over £40,000 p.a.
